Statutes require a district judge filling this position: (1) be regularly admitted to the practice of law in the State of Kansas; (2) be a resident of the Eleventh Judicial District at the time of taking the oath of office and maintain residency in the Eleventh Judicial District while holding such office; (3) have been engaged in the active practice of law for at least 5 years as either a lawyer, judge, or full-time teacher at an accredited law school. K.S.A. 20-334; see K.S.A. 4-222. Nonresidents of the Eleventh Judicial District should be aware of K.S.A. 20-2909(b).

8. Have you ever held judicial office or been a candidate for judicial office? If so, state the courts involved and the dates of service, including service as a judge pro tempore.
