Order Waiving Court Fees and Costs for Requests to Challenge Isolation or Quarantine Orders Resulting from the COVID-19 Pandemic

This order addresses court fees and costs to challenge isolation or quarantine orders resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. Under certain circumstances, a local health officer or the secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment may issue an order pursuant to K.S.A. 65-129b requiring an individual or a group of individuals to go to and remain in places of isolation or quarantine. If such an order is issued, the individual receiving the order may file a request in district court for a hearing under article 15 of chapter 60 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated.

Due to the need to protect the health and safety of the public and the rights of the individual served with such an order, the Court waives any court fees and costs associated with the filing of such a request.
