Order Authorizing use of Administrative Leave

This order complements Administrative Orders 2020-PR-13, 2020-PR-15 and 2020-PR-16 on actions to mitigate local or statewide outbreak of the COVID-19 disease.

On March 18, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Kansas Supreme Court, in consultation with the members of the Kansas Supreme Court, imposed statewide judiciary operational restrictions. The court further orders that administrative leave is authorized for judicial branch workforce members deemed non-essential during pandemic response. Receipt of administrative leave compensation will not impact basic terms and conditions of employment to include rate of pay, retirement benefits, court sponsored insurance coverage or leave accrual.
