<u>Probation Meetings</u>	2x/week	1x/week	Every 3 weeks	Monthly
<u>Drug/Alcohol Testing</u>	3x/week	2x/week	2x/week	Random
<u>Intensive Mental Health Services</u>	Engage and become oriented	Continue to meet and engage	Engage and work on prevention and emergency plan	Continue to meet based on treatment need
<u>Medication Services</u>	Attend all med appointments and take medications as directed (Monitor in phase 1 if necessary)			
<u>Cognitive Groups</u> (SS, WSM, MRT, TRACK, etc.)	Not yet engaged	Engage in criminal thinking program		
<u>Substance Treatment</u>	Assessment and begin to follow treatment as directed	Attend all required treatment groups	Begin wrapping up treatment groups	Complete treatment and recovery preparation
<u>Court Costs</u>	Develop a plan for payment	Continue plan for payment	Continue plan for payment	Have fees paid in full
<u>Curfew</u>	9:00PM	10:00PM	11:00PM	12:00AM
<u>Verified Sober Time</u>	14 days	30 days	45 days	60 days
<u>Requirements to Advance</u>	Regular attendance at treatment, office visits, overall compliance	Engage with treatment, overall compliance	Engage with treatment, begin prosocial activity & recovery network, address medical concerns, overall compliance	Develop aftercare plan, establish prosocial activity, engage in recovery network, begin job/voc., overall compliance
