

## GOVERNOR'S BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PLANNING COUNCIL

The federal government mandates that all states have a mental health services planning and advisory council. The Governor's Behavioral Health Services Planning Council fulfills that mandate for Kansas.
